The Alberta Practitioner Link/APLJobs.ca web site was developed, and is maintained and supported by The Alberta Physician Action Plan (RPAP).

The Mission of Alberta Practitioner Link/APLJobs.ca

To be the main Internet location for physician vacancies for publicly supported entities in Alberta, Canada and thereby support the recruitment efforts of those publicly supported entities and Alberta's communities.

Background

The origin of Alberta Practitioner Link/APLJobs.ca derived from RPAP's community physician recruitment activities with rural regional health authorities and Alberta rural communities starting in 2000. With the support of the Council of Medical Directors, Rural Physician Link was started in 2006 to be a central registry of rural Alberta physician practice opportunities, and in doing so, create a more competitive opportunity for those rural health regions and the province's urban health regions and their academic health centres.

Prior to the development of Rural Physician Link, practice opportunities were spread amongst the web sites of the province's regional health authorities and the Alberta Medical Association.

With the success of Rural Physician Link enabling rural health regions to more effectively promote rural physician practice opportunities and Alberta, Canada as a practice destination, the web site was evolved beginning in 2007 in line with the provinces health system reform and its Health Workforce Action Plan to the current Alberta Practitioner Link web site.

In the Fall of 2014, Alberta Physician Link was redeveloped into APLJobs.ca to incorporate new features and content and to enable job postings for health care practitioners in addition to physicians, in line with RPAP's support of Family Care Clinics and the province's primary health care system.

Today Alberta Practitioner Link/APLJobs.ca strives to meet the needs of:

- The province's publicly supported entities (Alberta Health Services, Covenant Health, Primary Care Networks/Family Care Clinics and new primary care models, individual physician practices, and academic departments) by posting their physician practice opportunities;
- Alberta's communities who work with those publicly supported entities to recruit physicians to their communities; and

- Prospective candidates including Alberta health care trainees and practitioners, and health care practitioners elsewhere in Canada and around the world who look for Alberta, Canada practice opportunities in publicly supported entities.
